<p><b>029.19 RAF Shawbury</b></p> <p>The Chairman welcomed Flt Lt Mike Tierney from RAF Shawbury.</p> <p>Mike informed the meeting that there would be an increase in flying over the coming months as a result of a backlog due to the arrival of the Helicopters.</p> <p>The new Station Commander, Group Captain Mullen will attend our Annual Parish Meeting in May. It was suggested that any questions that require some research for the Station Commander should be forwarded to the Parish Clerk by the end of April.</p> <p>There were no questions to raise with the RAF therefore the Chairman thanked Mike for his attendance who then left the meeting.</p>	All Cllr's
<p><b>030.19 Highway Matters</b></p> <p>Cllr's reported that all lines on the A53 had now been replaced.</p> <p>Cllr Nuria Gray reported large holes dug out by what looks like a JCB in the grass verge adjacent to Old Blakeley Stud which is a danger to passing vehicles.</p> <p>Cllr Chas Warren reported that as you come out of Stanton towards Ellerdine at the junction at end of village just before the entrance to The Oaks on the right and opposite Rock Farm there is a culvert running under the road which is not fenced off from the grass verge with a severe drop into the adjoining land and suggested highways are asked to fence this off.</p> <p>Cllr Greg Shaw reported a number of pot holes on the left hand side of the road next to the pumping station in High Hatton as you approach from the 'T' junction which require urgent attention.</p> <p>Cllr Chas Warren reported that recent repairs to pot holes as you approach the junction to Blakeley and A53 from Stanton are now breaking up again.</p> <p>As regards the proposed signs for Papermill Bank, Shona Butter from Shropshire Council had advised Cllr Doug Dee that the best solution would be for some proper Highway signs to be erected stating 'Unsuitable for Vehicles'</p>	<p>Parish Clerk</p> <p>Parish Clerk</p> <p>Parish Clerk</p> <p>Parish Clerk</p>
