Public Participation - There is concern over the speed of traffic coming out of Stanton Village and going down Harcourt Mill Lane, especially at night. The road signs as you approach this lane are confusing along with a lack of clear road markings. It was agreed to remove 'D' restriction signs and improve white lining.

Urgent Items - Installation of a basket ball hoop in the Play Area. A site has been agreed after consultation with neighbours. It was decided to install the basket ball hoop adjacent to the mound. The wooden stepping up to the slide also needs replacing.

RAF Shawbury - Mike Cauchi reported on two possible large housing developments being considered for planning in Shawbury. Although RAF Shawbury would not oppose these they may put in their concerns over aircraft noise affect, although neither of these proposed site would be on their flight paths.

Rivers - A further four days work has been carried out on both sides of the river from Stanton Bridge to Major's Woods. Thanks to many volunteers attending.

## DEFIBRILLATOR REFRESHER TRAINING & COMMUNITY LUNCHEON - VILLAGE HALL

On Sat 13 Dec at 0930 the Stanton HeartBeat (AED) Scheme are holding a refresher training session in the Village Hall for those people who have previously trained in Basic Life Support and the use of an AED. Representatives from West Midlands Ambulance service will also take the group through the necessary paperwork to get DBS checked (the old CRB checks). Folks will need to bring passport, driving license, National Insurance number, and a utility bill or council tax bill to prove current address. Following this at 1330 members of the Parish Council's Emergency Planning Committee will hold a free community luncheon. During lunch we will discuss how, as a community, we can support each other during emergencies like the power cuts we experienced last winter. ## December IN THE GARDEN



1. Check your winter protection structures are still securely in place.
2. Check that greenhouse heaters are working
3. Prevent ponds and stand pipes from freezing
4. Prune open-grown apples and pears (but not those trained against walls)
5. Prune acers, birches and vines to avoid bleeding
6. Harvest leeks, parsnips, winter cabbage, sprouts and remaining root crops.
7. Deciduous trees and shrubs can still be planted and transplanted.
8. Take hardwood cuttings
9. Keep mice away from stored produce
10. Reduce watering of house plants.
