AUGUST IN THE GARDEN

- 1. Check clematis for signs of clematis wilt
- 2.Place conservatory plants outside now that it is warm
- 3. Water tubs and new plants if dry, but be water-wise
- 4.Deadhead bedding plants and repeat-flowering perennials, to ensure continuous flowering
- 5. Pick courgettes before they become marrows
- 6. Treat apple scab
- 7.Clear algae, blanket weeds and debris from ponds, and keep them topped up
- 8. Order catalogues for next year's spring-flowering bulbs
- 9. Give the lawn a quick-acting summer feed, especially if not given a spring feed
- 10. Give woodwork a lick of paint or preserver, while the weather is dry

- 2. Prune Wisteria
- 3. Don't delay summer pruning restricted fruits
- 4. Deadhead flowering plants regularly
- 5. Watering! particularly containers, and new plants, preferably with grey recycled water or stored rainwater 6.Collect seed from favourite plants
- 7. Harvest sweetcorn and other vegetables as they become ready
- 8. Continue cutting out old fruited canes on raspberries
- 9. Lift and pot up rooted strawberry runners
- 10. Keep ponds and water features topped up
- 11. Feed the soil with green manures

Puy Lentil, spiced roast carrot & feta salad

Ingredients:

2 tbsp olive oil

1 tbsp cumin seed

500g carrots, peeled, halved and cut into batons

1 tbsp clear honey

250g pouch cooked Puy lentils (or canned, drained and rinsed)

1 red onion, finely sliced

1/2 lemon juice

Large handful mint leaves, roughly chopped 86g feta cheese crumbled

- 1. Heat the oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. In a shallow roasting tin, toss together half the oil, the cumin, carrots and some seasoning. Roast for 25
- mins, turning halfway through cooking. Drizzle over the honey, stir and roast for 5 mins more.
- 2. Meanwhile, gently heat the lentils with the onion, lemon juice, remaining oil and some salt and pepper. Allow to cool slightly while the carrots finish cooking.
- 3. Toss the dressed lentils with mint and lamb's lettuce. Lay warm spiced carrots on top and scatter with feta.
