- 1. Divide herbaceous perennials
- 2. Pick autumn raspberries
- 3. Collect and sow seed from perennials and hardy annuals
- 4. Dig up remaining potatoes before slug damage spoils them
- 5. Net ponds before leaf fall gets underway
- 6. Keep up with watering of new plants, using rain or grey water if possible
- 7. Start to reduce the frequency of houseplant watering
- 8. Clean out cold frames and greenhouses so that they are ready for use in the autumn
- 9. Cover leafy vegetable crops with bird-proof netting
- 10. Plant spring flowering bulbs

Keeping Warm through the Winter

In July the parish council had a presentation from Shropshire Rural Community Council on their **Fuel Buying Scheme**. This brings communities together to use joint buying power to reduce the cost of heating oil for both homes and businesses. There is an annual fee of £24, but if you would like to be the local co-ordinator for Stanton and High Hatton you can join for free. Orders are placed monthly and you can order as many times as you like during the year. Shropshire RCC then negotiates the best price available each month and members find that they save far more than the annual fee and do not have to ring round many suppliers each time they wish to place an order. More information is available directly from Shropshire RCC or from any parish councillor.

On Tuesday 2 September, the parish council will be having another presentation from Shropshire RCC, this time on their **Energy Champions** which is a way of tackling fuel poverty. Clive Leworthy, who will be coming to talk to us, wrote:

We identify and support people by working at a grassroots level, identifying individuals who are vulnerable to fuel poverty and working with the support organisations that can make a difference to people in fuel poverty. Volunteers are trained to give reliable information on:

- · making your home more energy efficient,
- special energy tariffs for those struggling to pay their heating bills,
- how to read your energy bill,
- how to access a free home energy audit,
- how to save money through communal oil buying,
- local and national opportunities for grants and loans to fund affordable warmth and energy efficiency measures in the home

Volunteers also work within their local community to raise awareness of the lack of affordable warmth, for example with their local parish council or good neighbour scheme.

Do come along to hear more about how this could help members of our community.
