MAY IN THE GARDEN



1. Keep weeds under control
2. Protect fruit blossom from late frosts
3. Tie in climbing and rambling roses
4. Sow hardy annuals and herb seeds
5. Start to feed citrus plants
6. Increase the water given to houseplants
7. Feed hungry shrubs and roses
8. Sow new lawns or repair bare patches
9. Prune fig trees
10. Divide bamboos and waterlilies

50g butter

1 medium onion, finely chopped

2 garlic cloves, finely chopped

1 medium potato, peeled and chopped into chunks

450ml chicken or vegetable stock

600ml milk

450g fresh spinach, washed if necessary and roughly chopped

finely grated zest of half a lemon

freshly grated nutmeg, to taste

3 tbsp double cream, to serve

CREAMY SPINACH SOUP

Melt the butter in a large lidded saucepan, add the onion and garlic and fry gently for 5-6 minutes until softening. Stir in the potato and continue to cook gently for 1 minute. Pour in the stock and simmer for 8-10 minutes until the potato starts to cook. Pour in the milk and bring up to a simmer, then stir in half the spinach and the lemon zest. Cover and simmer for 15 minutes until the spinach has completely wilted down. Allow to cool for about 5 minutes. Pour the soup into a blender or food processor, add the remaining spinach and process until silky smooth. Return to the pan and reheat. Taste and season with salt, pepper and nutmeg. You may like to dilute the soup with a little extra stock if too thick. Ladle the soup into bowls and swirl in the cream.
