Stoke Heath – Migration some background

In 2021 Shropshire councillors unanimously passed a motion to join the City of Sanctuary Local Authority Network. Theresa May signed up to the UN, Global Compact for Migration (GCM), an agreement that explicitly calls for states to “facilitate access for migrants in an irregular (sic) status” to a process that could award them amnesty. The Johnson government made it clear that the “GCM is fully integrated into the UK policy architecture, that GCM principles are reflected in wider UK migration policy and maintains senior official/ministerial focus on the GCM”. Did You Know.....that 100 years ago in July 1926— First greyhound racing track in Britain opens in Manchester. The Government of Canada returned to the gold standard, and allowed its bank notes to be redeemed for gold.
