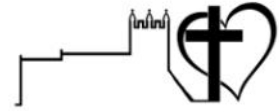

**Did You Know.....**that 100 years ago in May 1926 The Trade Union Congress (TUC) calls for a general strike in Britain to support miners facing wage cuts and longer hours, which officially begins just before midnight. In Poland, Józef Piłsudski leads the "May Coup," taking control of the government. Sholom Schwartzbard assassinates Symon Petliura, leader of the Ukrainian government-in-exile, in Paris. The Rif War in Morocco ends with the surrender of Rif rebels. A military coup occurs in Portugal, led by General Manuel Gomes da Costa, leading to a long-term dictatorship.

**Fuel Theft**

As heating oil prices rise, so does the value of your tank's contents and the risk of fuel theft.

Oil tanks are an easy target because they're outdoors, often out of sight, and contain valuable fuel that can be siphoned quickly and quietly. Fortunately, there are plenty of simple, affordable ways to make your tank far less appealing to criminals.

**Make Your Oil Tank Less Visible**

Making your tank less visible from the road is an effective way to deter opportunists. Trellis panels, shrubs, or a standalone fence panel can help obscure the tank from view. The aim is to keep it discreet without creating full cover that gives thieves complete privacy. Be sure to maintain a separation gap around your tank – Building Regulations require trellis and boundaries to be a minimum of 760mm away from any part of your oil tank.

**Improve Lighting Around the Tank**

Good lighting is one of the most effective low-cost deterrents. Motion-activated lights illuminate the area when someone approaches, instantly drawing attention. Solar lights are inexpensive, simple to install, and don't require battery changes.

Fit a Lockable Cap or Lid

A quality locking cap is inexpensive and can significantly slow down would-be thieves. Lockable filler caps, anti-tamper caps, and padlocks make siphoning more difficult.

### **Shropshire Surface Dressing Programme – Summer 2026**

The following roads are programmed for Surface Dressing between **Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May to Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May during the hours of 9:30am to 4pm Weekdays & 6am to 6pm Weekends.**

Site 33 - C2093 from Jct A53 The Avenue To A49 Lee Brockhurst, Stanton Upon Hine Heath  
Site 61 - C2102 Booley Road End Of Stanton To Moston Jct Booley, Stanton Upon Hine Heath

The work is currently programmed to take place as follows: -

**10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> May** – Road Closure for Surface Dressing

**18<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> May** – Road Closure for White Lining

Please Note – Only one Surface Dressing site will be closed at any one time.

The road will have an initial sweep within 24 hours of the new surface being laid. The sweeper returns after 7 days to remove any residual loose chippings.

#### **How will this affect traffic?**

Signs will be erected in the road before starting the work and the work will be completed as quickly as possible. A signed diversion route will be in place as per map below.

#### **Will there be access to my property/business?**

Yes, if you are looking to access a property or business, we will provide access for you.

We will have staff on site who are able to assist with access. Our priority is to keep you and our staff safe, this means that there may be a bit of a wait while we make the site safe for you to travel through the closure or direct you to another entry point.

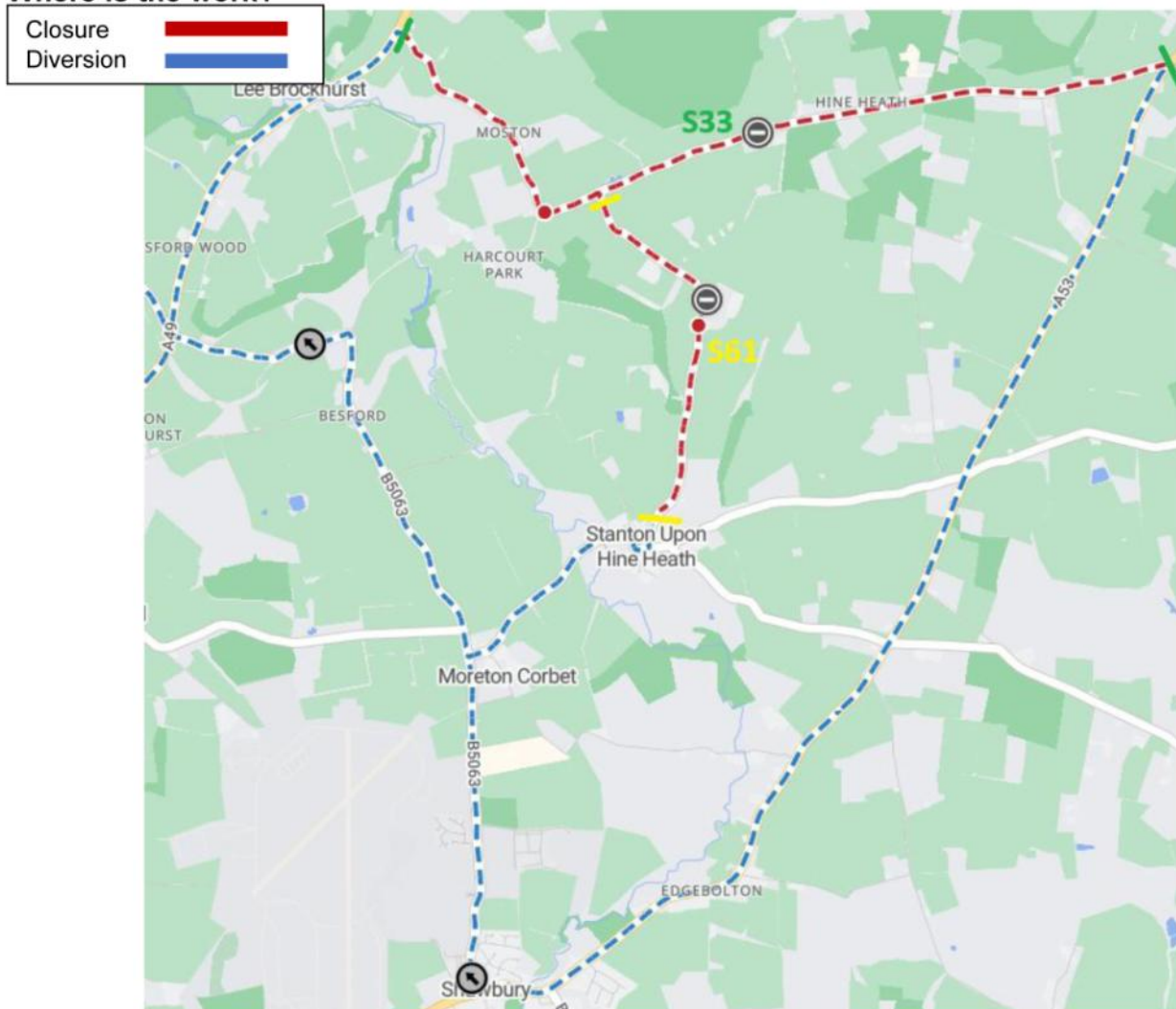
During the work, access to the works area will be restricted to:

- Residents who live and reside within the road closure.
- Businesses located within the closure (if applicable)
- Emergency vehicles

#### **How can you help us?**

Please ensure vehicles are not parked on the road during the day whilst the work is in progress. Please be mindful that we can only provide access for properties/businesses within the work area.

### Where is the work?



### Why use Surface Dressing?

- To improve the skid resistance of the road surface.
- To seal the road against ingress of water, preventing potholes forming in winter.
- To extend the life of an existing surface and arrest deterioration of the surface.
- Surface dressing is a preventative method of maintenance. The process does not reshape or increase the strength of the road.
