- Plan the consultation (questionnaire, online survey or other method (Winter 2016-17)
- Do the consultation (Spring 2017)
- Collate and present the results (Summer/ Autumn 2017)

If a group cannot be formed we will not be able to prove that we

have properly asked the community for their views and so will lose our chance to influence planning and other decisions. The Parish Council have supported this attempt to make a community plan and will use the results when asked for comments from Shropshire Council.

Ever since moving to Shawbury in 1978 I have been involved as a volunteer in the community; playschool, Sunday School and summer holiday play scheme for starters. Around 26 years ago I took over the newsletter, which was initially a Church news sheet. The process then involved a friend typing the articles, cutting, sticking, tippexing out the outlines to get a decent master copy fit for printing. With computers the process became much easier and first one computer colleague came on board, followed by a second, up to a few years ago when it became a family affair. During all this time nearly 40 distributors have diligently delivered a copy to every household each month, including the RAF camp. Some of these helpers date back to my first year, maybe even before then, and I would like to take this opportunity to say a HUGE THANK YOU to everyone involved.

With the new Village Hall came a major role in running it, overseeing the bookings, invoicing and housekeeping for 10 years. As organist and treasurer for Shawbury and Stanton Churches for decades, many of you would know me from selling raffle tickets, house to house, for the Church summer fete which I organised for 17 years with loads of help from loads of people and this again gives me chance to thank all of them publicly. Several years ago, with Parish Council backing, we started the Buzz In, a weekly community café in the Village Hall.

Out of an even longer list these are my main achievements. Moving to Shawbury was one of our best decisions. When you become involved in community life the rewards are far greater than any inconvenience incurred. When I had to give everything up in February last year to be treated over a 6 month period for leukaemia there was a bit of a panic but thankfully people came forth and everything continued. Once again many, many thanks to all concerned and in particular to the 10 people who got landed with a job, not necessarily from choice! I am now back involved (to a lesser degree) and must say I have thoroughly enjoyed playing a useful part in the life of such a lovely village with such lovely people.

My good news mentioned earlier is that I have been awarded a BEM (British Empire Medal) which I will receive at a local ceremony from the Lord Lieutenant and will be invited to a Buckingham Palace garden party next summer. One last thank you – to the anonymous kind person who nominated me. Frances Medley

Horse Watch now has a Trailer Watch Scheme available for a £1.50 donation. Upon receipt of registration and donation you will be issued with a West Mercia Horse Watch security skin that measures 80 x 35mm.

"Please note, if you wish WMHW to mark the skin for you with UV please advise what details you require."

This is a simple product made of a high polymer material that protects UV markings, yet shows any element of tamper the skins fragment into tiny pieces when removal is attempted.

You do not have to use UV markings you can use Any marker then place the skin over the top of the mark of ID names, postcodes etc to protect it.
